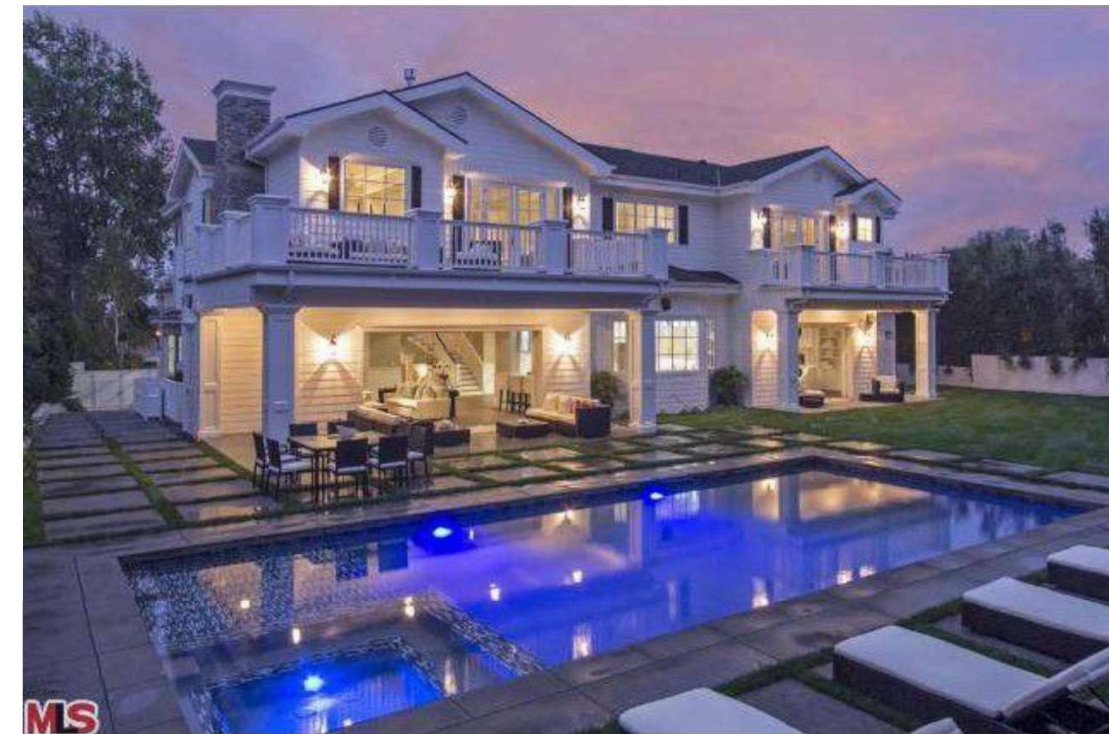


Tour Blake Griffin's \$9 Million Home in Pacific Palisades

[Los Angeles Clippers](#) superstar Blake Griffin has scored major style points for his multimillion-dollar purchase in [Pacific Palisades, CA](#).

The [L.A. Times](#) reports that Griffin recently spent \$9 million on a custom-built "Cape Cod-inspired" property in the popular celebrity alcove found between Malibu and Santa Monica. The [NBA](#) All-Star's new home court touts 9,100 square feet of living space spread across three floors, with a range of high-end amenities and luxuries befitting one of basketball's brightest young stars.

The [athlete's home](#) features a vaulted foyer and a stylish floating staircase, dark hardwood flooring and delicate coffered ceilings. In the amenities department, there's a gourmet kitchen, a home theater with stadium seating, a gym and three fireplaces. The master bathroom -- one of six bedroom suites -- boasts a spa-like bath and walk-in closet.

Outdoors, the three-acre property is prime for entertaining. A saltwater pool comes complete with multi-colored LED lighting and wired surround sound, and an outdoor kitchen looks ripe for summer cookouts.

With the purchase, Griffin joins Miami Heat forward Chris Bosh and former Los Angeles Lakers center Vlade Divac as notable basketball residents in Pacific Palisades. Bosh was previously renting out [his resort-like mansion](#) in the Palisades last year for \$45,000 a month, and [Divac currently asks \\$3.25 million](#) for his own chrome and stucco contemporary.

Anthony Marguleas of Amalfi Estates had the listing. David Offer of Berkshire Hathaway HomeServices and Chase Campen of Keller Williams represented Griffin in the sale.
