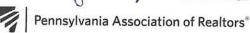

Section 4 - Roofs and Attic

Roof Repair - In 1997 we repaired the flat roof and the front porch roof including the valley. In 2000, we repaired the right-side roof including the dormer. In 2010 we repaired the valley above the flat roof in the back. In 2011 we repaired the rear upper roof including the dormer.

Section 5 - Basements and Crawl Spaces

Water infiltration - I think it was in 2007 we had a frozen rainstorm that left the driveway with about 2" of ice. Then we had another heavy rainstorm, and the water did not have a place to go. Water started bubbling up from below the basement slab where the previous owner had drilled holes in the flooring to treat the termites. This led to us installing a French drain with sump and automatic sump pump in the basement. At the same time, we also installed gutter guards to better channel the water away from the house. We have never seen water infiltration in the basement since.

Section 6 - Termites/Wood-Destroying Insects, Dry rot, Pests

Termites - When purchased the house, the termite report showed termite damage. The seller treated the basement with available technology. Since then, we have not seen any active termites nor damage.

Yearly Terminix Plan. All reports/findings documented and there has been no active termite activity or damage found since our ownership.

Section 7 - Structural Items

- 1 Porch repair In 2006 the front patio roof was pulling away from the house. We completely redid the foundation, replaced the support columns, and jacked up the roof to its original position.
- 2 Right side retaining wall When we purchased the house, there was a slate patio on the right side of the property line. Water from the garage roof next door, drained on this patio and slowly pushed the retaining wall away from the house, towards the neighbor's garage. We installed a French drain that connected to the storm drain. In 2015 the wall fell. This retaining wall was then replaced from the back of the neighbor's garage until about 10' from the front sidewalk. The area was then landscaped.
- 3 Stucco repair There has not been any major repair work needed. The stucco was painted a few years ago.
- 4 Deck Installation In 2000, a Cedar Deck was installed. After 18 years, the deck had to be replaced. In 2018 a new deck using TREX material replaced the Cedar.
 - 5 Stone Pointing In 2008, all stonework was repointed.
- 6 Kitchen/Den remodeling In 2012, we went to an open concept between the kitchen and den by knocking down the separating wall. The entire area was gutted, walls insulated, and support wall in the basement reinforced. All new appliances were added along with an island. We added a surround sound system to the den. All flooring was replaced with solid oak floors.

Section 8 - Additional Alterations

- 1 Front Door In 2004, we had the front door threshold repaired due to poor sealing when closed. At the same time, we replaced the outside screen door.
- 2 Powder room remodeling In 2006, we remodeled the powder room on the first floor. It included a new sink and vanity. The outside wall was insulated.
- 3 Shared second floor bathroom remodeling After a 3rd floor leak that damaged the second-floor bathroom, we totally remodeled the bathroom adding about 14" to its width. The vanity, medicine chest, floor, bathtub, and toilet were

replaced. An exhaust fan was installed along with appropriate lighting. Water supply to both bathrooms were isolated from one another and all piping used was the new PEX material.

- 4 Shutter replacement In 2004, we replaced the existing shutters on the second-floor windows.
- 5 New Garage Door and opener In 2009, we replaced the garage door and opener. The new door is insulated.
- 6 Garage Cabinets In 2010, garage cabinets were installed as well as hanging tool organizers.
- 7 Master bedroom closet organizers. These were installed in the single closet in 2010.
- 8 Front walkway redone In 2016, the front walkway to the home entrance was repaired. The top stones were removed and reused after the foundation was completely replaced.
- 9 Asbestos removal When we purchased the home in 1985 all hot water heating supply and return lines were found to have asbestos insulation. Thus, we contracted to have all the asbestos removed.

Section 13 - Heating System

1 - Heater Replacement - In 2002 we replaced the existing boiler with a newer unit and created 4 zones for heating

Section 14 - Air Conditioning System

- 1 High Velocity A/C In 1997 we had a high velocity A/C installed that cooled the $2^{\rm nd}$ and $3^{\rm rd}$ floors,
- 2 Conventional A/C. In 2010 we had a conventional A/A system installed that cooled the 1^{st} floor.

Section 15 - Electrical System

New Electrical Control - The electrical system was upgraded during the Kitchen/Den project.

Knob & Tube wiring - When we purchased the house the previous owner disclosed that the electrical system was upgraded, which eliminated 90% of the knob & Tub wiring. We think the remaining Knob & Tube wiring is still active in the attic. Whenever we run into it during renovations, we eliminate it.

Section 18 - Windows

Casement Windows Replacements (1stFloor) – In 1987 we replaced all casement windows on the $1^{\rm st}$ floor with vinyl multi-layer glass windows.

Pella Windows Replacements (all double hung and any remaining casements and +1/4 windows in the attic) - In 2005 we replaced all remaining windows (mostly double hung style) on all three floors.

Section 20 - Flooding, Drainage, and Boundaries

We had a bad storm (remnants of a hurricane), all the leaves were blown off a back yard tree. The tree subsequently died and removed. After this the driveway drain no longer functioned. Investigating further, we found a large drywell (we think) below where the tree was removed. The unit had a vent that was plugged and when opened, the drain started functioning again.

<u>Section 22 -Insurance Claims</u> - There have been several insurance claims made on the house

Shower lead pan leak

Major 3rd floor bathroom leaked in 2017. Damaged the shared 2nd floor bathroom and kitchen/den ceiling, and garage cabinets.
